GRADE: COMPLETED KINDERGARTEN OR PREFIRST

DESCRIPTION: CALLING ALL INCOMING PREFIRST AND FIRST GRADE STUDENTS! THIS CLASS IS DESIGNED TO CHALLENGE STUDENTS AS THEY CONTINUE TO MAKE TREMENDOUS GROWTH IN THE FOUR CORE ACADEMIC AREAS. EACH CHILD'S INDIVIDUAL LEARNING NEEDS WILL BE MET USING STRATEGIES OF SMALL GROUP GUIDED READING, WRITING EXPLORATION, AND PHONICS REINFORCEMENT. MATH CONCEPT DEVELOPMENT WILL BE STRENGTHENED THROUGH HANDS-ON ACTIVITIES.

BACK TO BASICS II

GRADE: COMPLETED GRADE 1

INSTRUCTOR: ERICA BOWMAN

SUPPLY FEE: \$35

DESCRIPTION: THIS CLASS WILL SUPPORT INCOMING SECOND GRADERS IN THEIR CONTINUED DEVELOPMENT OF BASIC SKILLS. THE CLASS WILL INCLUDE THEMATIC LITERATURE PROJECTS DESIGNED TO STRENGTHEN LITERACY SKILLS, WHICH INCLUDE READING, WRITING, AND SPELLING. READING FLUENCY AND COMPREHENSION WILL BE ADDRESSED. COMPUTATION, PROBLEM-SOLVING AND OTHER MATHEMATICS CONCEPTS SUCH AS TELLING TIME, COUNTING MONEY AND EXPLORING PATTERNS WILL BE REINFORCED THROUGH HANDS-ON ACTIVITIES.
